Who we need: We are looking for an Assembler to join our team. Work may be performed under a microscope while using small hand tools and with table top adjustment fixtures. Monitors work-in-process or completed work, may need to disassemble, modify and rework as required. This position continually rotates through a variety of manufacturing processes, performing all types of tasks in a cell/team environment.

What you will do:

- Assemble and add small components to chassis.
- Assemble and align optics using mechanical and adhesive processes.
- Soldering printed circuit boards and various types of connections. Assembly of mechanical components using prints or written instructions.
- Bolts, clips, screws, cements, or otherwise fastens parts together.
- Works at different work stations as production needs require.
- Assemble grips and bumpers on housings using mechanical and adhesive processes.
- Reads work orders, follows production drawings and sample assemblies, or receives verbal instructions regarding duties to be performed.
- Inspects parts, assemblies and products throughout the production process.
- Attends, passes, and participates in various training programs such as OSHA and related safety classes, quality classes, production techniques classes and workshops, etc.
- Performs other related tasks that includes, housekeeping tasks required to keep work area clean and organized and other duties and special projects as assigned.
- Observes all safety rules and regulations including wearing protective equipment when required. Reports any unsafe conditions to management.
- Demonstrated ability to handle various small hand tools. Must be able to use a microscope. Ability to identify root cause of assembly related discrepancies/issues and communicate to supervisor and/or lead.
- Will use cleaners such as alcohol, window cleaner and solvents as needed.
- Must ability to work as part of a team and coordinate with other employees as required
- Other duties as needed.

What you need:

- 2 years' experience in optical/electronic/mechanical assembly and soldering experience within the past 12 months is required.

- Candidate must be able to demonstrate soldering proficiency.
